COVID-19 Update & Mask Clarification

In case you haven't heard, the Safer at Home Order has been extended until **Friday, May 15th**. This means that the Business Office, Security Office, and all Recreational Facilities will remain <u>CLOSED</u> through May 15th.

It appears that there may be some confusion as to the wearing of masks within our community and clarification has become warranted. Primarily, six-foot distancing is required unless persons are family members or from the same household. If that procedure is followed, masks ARE NOT required unless visiting Essential Businesses. This includes ALL members of our staff in Friendly Valley. To be clear, presently, as long as proper social distancing is in practice, masks ARE NOT required to be worn while performing outside activities such as walking, jogging or bike riding. If any individual resident feels that additional protection is required, it is their prerogative to protect themselves as they see fit. But, it is not up to any individual resident to suggest or imply that an unmasked party, that is practicing proper social distancing, is also required to wear a mask in public.

We have encountered many changes over the last several weeks and we have adjusted our community policies accordingly. If this present mandate from the County of Los Angeles, who dictates our compliance, becomes updated, Friendly Valley will adopt the newest changes.
