Upcoming Revisions to the FVRA General Policies of Operations & Management

At the August 7th Community Council Meeting, Community Council voted to make a recommendation to the Rec Board regarding the Pool and Spa Hours. The Rec Board has decided to discuss and vote on this recommendation. The Rec Board of Directors is proposing a permanent change to the Friendly Valley Recreational Association General Policies of Operations and Management Pool Rules and Regulations section.

<u>HOBBY ROOMS</u>: Billiards, Ceramics, Woodshop, and Sewing Room are available to all residents and will be opened upon request between 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. All sign-in sheets and disclaimers MUST be signed prior to using the room or equipment.

#### PROPOSED LANGUAGE:

<u>HOBBY ROOMS</u>: Game Room, Ceramics, Woodshop, and Poker Room are available to all residents and will be opened upon request between 6:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. All sign-in sheets and disclaimers MUST be signed prior to using the room or equipment. [Changes in italics]

The Rec is also proposing to replace the Senior Citizen Housing Development Definition and Policy paragraph with revisions that were suggested by the attorneys involved in the CA Civil Code 51.3 Review Project.

#### **CURRENT LANGUAGE:**

This Senior Citizen community refers to California Civil Code Section 51.3 for all definitions and restrictions. One person in residence must be a senior citizen 55 years of age or older; each other resident, except the spouse or cohabitant or a person who resides with and provides primary physical or economic support to the senior citizen, must be at least 45 years of age. Temporary residence as a guest of a senior citizen by a person less than 45 years of age is permitted only for a maximum period of 90 days in a 12 month period.

#### PROPOSED LANGUAGE:

Friendly Valley Country Club is a Senior Citizen Housing Development which complies with applicable state and federal regulations. Please see the Friendly Valley Rules & Regulations for definitions and policy. [Changes in italics]

Residents are invited to comment on these changes at the **September 9, 2019 Regular Board Meeting**. The Board will then vote on whether to permanently revise the Friendly Valley Recreational Association General Policies of Operations and Management Pool Rules and Regulations, Hobby Rooms, and Senior Citizen Housing Development sections to reflect the language proposed above.

#### **Estate Sales [Continued]:**

#### Garage / Estate Sales

Public sales of new or used personal property, typically called 'garage sales', may not be conducted from residences or from the common area within Friendly Valley. Residents of Friendly Valley may conduct an Estate Sale for the purpose of selling items which are no longer needed because of a move out of Friendly Valley. Qualifying moves include death, being in escrow for a move to a new location outside of FV, imminent relocation to an assisted living or nursing home, etc. Moving to another unit within FV does not qualify as a move out of Friendly Valley. Those wishing to conduct an Estate Sale must obtain a copy of the detailed Estate Sale Procedure and Permit Form from the Security Office. [Revised 11/21/01, 7/3/19]
