Hello all, the Business Office staff are being inundated with questions regarding the new Spectrum contract. We thought it would be beneficial to answer some of the most frequently asked questions regarding the new contract that is effective as of August 1, 2018.

Frequently Asked Questions

- "Do I need to change or do anything?"
 - The Business Office does not have a list of residents' accounts or equipment, so the answer is different for every individual. Spectrum can assist you.
 - Call Spectrum at 833-697-7328 OR
 - Visit the nearest Spectrum store at <u>26500 Carl Boyer Dr., Santa Clarita, CA 91350</u>
- "Spectrum is asking me for an account number."
 - FV Residents do not need to provide an account number, they only need to mention the Friendly Valley Bulk Contract that is effective as of August 1, 2018.
 - If the Spectrum representative does not understand or know what the bulk contract is, you will need to hang up and try calling Spectrum again for another representative.
- "How much money am I going to save?"
 - The amount of money you will be saving depends on the internet package you were using before the date of this new contract.
 - Please call Spectrum because they can tell you what your previous bills were vs. what you will pay now (if you will pay a bill at all)

Reminder: What the Contract Covers

- Under the bulk contract, every Friendly Valley resident is entitled to:
 - Cable:
 - (2) Spectrum Receivers -or- (2) DVR's
 - The new receivers will provide access to Spectrum TV Select and Digi Tier 1 channels
 - Internet:
 - (1) modem that will provide Spectrum Internet

Reminder: What is NOT included

- Equipment and services that are not a part of the bulk contract will have to be paid for by the residents, and they will be billed monthly by Spectrum
- Items not covered in the bulk contract include (but are not limited to): Additional receivers, Premium Channels, On Demand, and Spectrum Voice
