#### FRIENDLY VALLEY PARKWAY REPAVING PROJECT

Reminder: The project is set to begin on <u>February 18, 2019</u>, weather permitting. The project will be completed over a 2-week period. #### **New Gym**

The Rec Board has received several comments, concerns, and suggestions regarding the fitness center equipment. In response, we have evaluated and determined that the existing Universal gym is no longer acceptable for use by our residents. It is in the best interest of our community to replace some of the equipment with more modern and versatile machines that better guarantee safety and the ease of operation for both men and women.

Once the new gym is installed, we plan on reorganizing the room to accommodate the most useful and popular devices. To assist us in doing this, we began the process of evaluating the usage of other pieces of equipment. To start our survey, for a two-week period, work out participants will find a sign-in-sheet dedicated exclusively to the Bow Flex machine. When you use this machine, please chart your usage times so we can compile accurate data which will aid us in making the correct decisions to upgrade the center. One completed, surveys on other equipment will follow.
