Wealth of Information

I would like to highlight the many resources available to Friendly Valley residents. Before calling the Office to ask a question, residents are encouraged to look for the answers in the resources we have available:

- Friendly Valley Directory: Lists important phone numbers and numbers for your convenience, contractors, and the names, phone numbers, and addresses of Friendly Valley residents. The Directory with updated resident phone numbers and contractors came out in February of this year. The new Directory will be available early next year. The Directory also includes the following, which were sent to every homeowner and resident on April 24th of this year:
 - <u>Friendly Valley Rules and Regulations</u>: Here you will find community-wide rules regarding pets, guests, gate cards, parking, penalties applicable to violations, and hearings, among others.
 - <u>General Policies of Operations and Management</u>: This includes Use of Facilities by Residents and Groups, information about the Recreational Facilities, Golf and Pool Rules, etc.
- <u>Bulletin Board</u>: located in the FV Auditorium, this is a place where *residents* can post items they are looking for or selling, units being rented, etc. Posts must fit on a 3x5 index card and are posted for a maximum of 30 days. Please bring your card to the Business Office and one of the staff members will post it.

Residents are also encouraged to check out Channel 1390 and the Villager Newsletter for reminders, general announcements, and information regarding clubs, classes, and groups. Friendly Valley also has a website with a plethora of valuable information: www.friendlyvalleycountryclubwebsite.com.

- Contractors listed in the FV Directory pay a fee to be listed and they are <u>NOT</u> affiliated with or endorsed by Friendly Valley Recreational Association, the Business Office Staff, or Association Board of Directors.
- Posting of referrals on the Bulletin Board does <u>NOT</u> imply endorsement by the Friendly Valley Recreational Association, Business Office Staff, or any of the Association Board or Directors.

Frequently Asked Questions

- New Vehicle? Until you receive your registration from the DMV, you cannot register your vehicle (receive a
 decal). Instead, you must get a temporary Parking Pass from the Security Office. Switching a decal from
 your old vehicle to your new one is not permitted and you will be cited by Security.
- What if my guest arrives after normal business hours? Please notify the employees at the Guard Gate
 and somebody will be sent down to the Security Office to issue a Parking Pass.
- Association Responsibility vs. Homeowner Responsibility? More often than not, the answer is
 determined by the location of the issue. Check your CC&R's to see what the Association is responsible for.
 If you still have questions, come to the office and fill out a Request Form to your Board.




