Steve Garey doesn't reside here with us. You do not know him, but you may wish you did. Mr. Garey was a very accomplished pianist. He has been honored with two gold records and has entertained five U.S. Presidents. Quite the resume, I'm sure you would agree. One of those that you hear about, read about, see once in person or maybe even may be a tad bit jealous of the gift they possess.

But, in 2010, Mr. Garey became a victim of an unprovoked and vicious random assault on a street outside of his gated community in Palm Desert; a community much like our own. The gift he possessed was snatched from him by the callousness of that act. After years of hospital stays, surgeries, and rehabilitation, he was left wheel-chair bound. The savings from his life's work was exhausted in order to render him only daily existence. He was relegated to a small apartment; imprisoned and cursed by the music that still courses through his veins, scratching and clawing in its attempt to escape. The attack left him powerless to release that passion; maybe a fate worse than never having it. His days of being the top-rated "Liberace Protégé" became just a memory for him. And, if he still even had one, his cherished piano keyboard would now lie un-played.

But, sometimes in life, for unknown reasons, the stars still align for all of us!

Years ago, a Hammond Elegante organ was donated to our community. It has slept in hibernation for years, virtually unnoticed in a lonely corner of our auditorium. It is the same model that Mr. Garey once played when he began his musical journey many years ago as a travelling representative for the Hammond Company. And, although he can no longer compose melodies on the piano, he *is* able to release some of his genius by means of an organ!

I am going to deliver that instrument to where it belongs. With help from my neighbor, Linda Davies, who works for the SCV Senior Center, Mr. Billy Kornfield, the owner of Camelot Movers, was contacted and has graciously arranged to transport and deliver the piece to Cathedral City.

But, before transportation, it will be necessary to have the organ inspected, serviced, and repaired in order to ensure that Steve smiles when his fingers once again press the keys to create music. If I have to pay the technician to inspect and tune what was found to be a workable instrument, I will. The smile on Mr. Garey's face will be more than worth it to me. But what about all of you? Should I be so selfish? Shouldn't I share this chance to allow all of you to become a part of this with me? I decided that I will.

From tomorrow morning until **Friday**, **July 5**th, there will be a donation box in the Business Office that will transform your gifts into smiles of your own. That box will hold a collection that betters this man's life. You will get no accolades or recognition for your generosity, but what you will get is the self-satisfaction that you helped someone who has drawn a bad hand in life and that you gave him an Ace card to play. Any affordable contribution will bond you in a one-time chance to a very special and giving community. Opportunities like these don't come often. I'm not letting this chance go by...will you?
