Hello All, the following are a few important announcements.

## Children Pool Hours Change

At the October 3, 2018 Community Council Meeting, Community Council voted to extend the Pool Hours for Children. Community Council did not have the authority to change this rule, as it is present in the Friendly Valley Recreational Association General Policies of Operations and Management, which are only amendable by the F.V. Recreational Association. The Rec Board has decided to take Community Council's vote to extend the Pool Hours for Children as a recommendation. The Board of Directors is proposing a permanent change to the Friendly Valley Recreational Association General Policies of Operations and Management Pool Rules and Regulations section.

#### **CURRENT LANGUAGE:**

The swimming pool area is open to children from 11 a.m. -2 p.m. each day. The therapeutic hot pool is for adults 18 years of age and older. [Revised 12/30/13]

## PROPOSED LANGUAGE:

The swimming pool area is open to children from 11 a.m. – 2 p.m. each day. The swimming pool area is also open to children from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Wednesdays and from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Saturdays. The therapeutic hot pool is for adults 18 years of age and older. [Change in italics]

Residents are invited to comment on this change at the June 10, 2019 Regular Board Meeting. The Board will then vote on whether to permanently revise the Friendly Valley Recreational Association General Policies of Operations and Management Pool Rules and Regulations section to reflect the language proposed above. In the meantime, we will continue to abide by the Children's Pool Hours that Community Council has recommended.
