Hello everyone, this week's article will be about the procedures that the Business Office <u>must follow</u> in the event of someone passing away, and the importance of having your Will and/or Trust on file in the Business Office.

Please note that we are <u>NOT</u> attorneys and we <u>CANNOT</u> give legal advice, but what we can do is inform you of the procedures that we must follow because we are a gated community.

Procedure

The following is what we were instructed by an attorney. Because we are a gated community, we <u>must</u> abide by the following procedure:

- If the resident was the only person living in the unit, the guest list will be shut down.
- Friends and Family members will <u>not</u> be able to access the property. They will be escorted to the Business Office to speak with the staff and provide the necessary paperwork.
- Necessary Paperwork includes:
 - WILL: Letter of Authorization. According to our attorney, a Will is not sufficient for us to allow
 access to a unit. We must have a Letter of Authorization, which is a Court-ordered document. This is
 often a lengthy process and cannot be done ahead of time.
 - TRUST: Certification of Trust. This document is provided by the Business Office. The Successor Trustee must come in, provide their driver's license, proving that they are in fact the Successor Trustee, and they must notarize a document stating that the Trust we have on file is accurate and true. This also cannot be done ahead of time but the process is much quicker.
- NOBODOY CAN ACCESS THE UNIT UNLESS THE PROPER PAPERWORK IS PROVIDED.
- It is important to note that Power of Attorney (POA) is only effective while you are still living.

Keep it on File

Whether you have a Will or Trust, the following pages are needed: the cover page, the page that names the Executor/Successor Trustee, the signature page, and the notary page. Please bring your Will and/or Trust into the Business Office and the staff will take the necessary copies and put them in your file. Once the paperwork is brought in and put in your individual file, it stays in your file until the day that it is needed. Further, this means that it is not released to anyone; it is only used by the staff in the Business Office to verify who can access your property after you pass away.

Keep Family Members Informed

- It may be a good idea to show this article to your family members so they are aware of our procedures, because it is better than being blindsided during a difficult time.
- Food for Thought: if you know and take care of this ahead of time, it will be one less thing that you and your family members will need to worry about.

Final Thoughts

This topic is a difficult and uncomfortable one, but the conversation needs to be had in order to prevent the stress and headache later on. Please remember that the procedures that are in place are in place for a reason—the most important being liability. The procedures listed above must be followed in order to make sure that the people who should have access to your unit and belongings, will, and those that should not have access, will not. Please also remember that the staff members are not here to make you or your family members' lives difficult, they are here to guide and assist and follow the procedures that are in place. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
