Most of you now know about Mr. Garey's story and our chance to help write a happier chapter – so I thought I would provide an update to you all. A few months ago, the community of Friendly Valley decided to become "organ donors". On August 28th at about 11 AM, Mr. Steve Garey became the thrilled recipient of a Hammond organ that had rested silently for years gathering mothballs in a quiet corner of our auditorium.

Mr. Billy Cornfield, the owner of Camelot Moving and Storage, generously donated his truck and crew to professionally deliver the piece to Cathedral City, where Mr. Garey had been patiently waiting for its arrival. Accompanying it on the journey was a Yamaha piano that was donated by Phillip Cooke, musician and resident of Association #5. As it turns out, it was fortunate that he did – that piano is being played!



Unfortunately, when Mr. Garey went to play a melody on the organ, there was nothing but silence. I'm sure you can imagine the reaction of a man who has endured years of pain and suffering and waited so patiently for a glimmer of happiness, to have it taken away and end up right back where he started. Even though we contracted with an organ specialist to ensure us that the unit was operational prior to shipment, sometimes, even the best of intentions become stymied by the fates. So, much to Mr. Garey's dismay, the instrument once again lies dormant.

BUT help is on the way! The generous donations of the good people of Friendly Valley were collected for a purpose. That purpose was to better a life. It still is. And even a fiendish, unsympathetic setback won't be able to deter that intention. This morning, the excess funds collected for the inspection, repair, and transportation of the Hammond Organ to Palm Desert were mailed in the form of a Cashier's Check to Mr. Garey. The funds will pay for him to have the organ repaired and finally allow his fingers make their long-anticipated acquaintance with its keys. And I hope they stay the best of friends for the rest of their days together!
